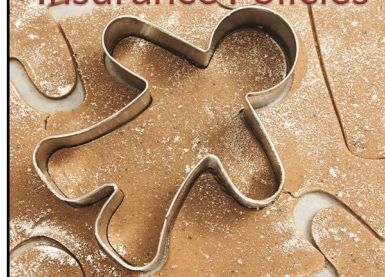

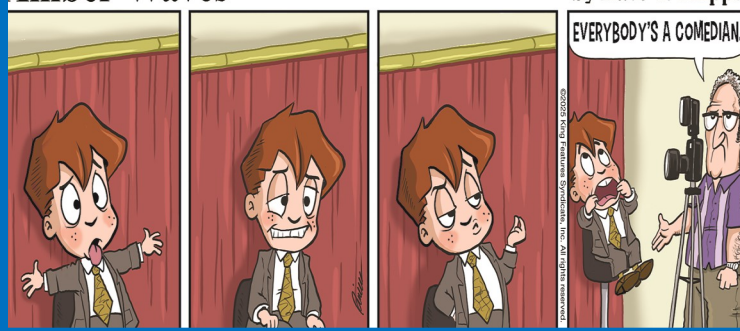

THE HISTORY CHANNEL

* On Sept. 15, 1916, British troops employed tanks for the first time in history, during an offensive against the Germans during the Battle of the Somme. While some were too slow to hold their positions during the German counterattack and were subject to mechanical failure, General Douglas Haig realized their potential and ordered the war department to produce hundreds more.



* On Sept. 16, 1845, Phineas Wilcox was stabbed to death by fellow Mormons in Nauvoo, Illinois, on suspicion of being a Christian spy. The crime reflected the frequently violent conflict between the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints and surrounding communities.

* On Sept. 17, 1967, British rock band The Who ended their nationally televised performance of their hit "My Generation" on "The Smothers Brothers Comedy Hour" with a literal bang from a blast of fireworks that Keith Moon had packed into his bass drum. Guitarist Pete Townshend's hair was badly singed, Moon's arm was hit with shrapnel and the show was momentarily knocked off the air, but everyone survived intact.

Mushrooms are harvested year-round. The white button is the favorite variety in the U.S., with baby bellas, portabellas, oyster and shiitake also popular.

Mushrooms are 90% water, and they do not need sunlight to grow.

Maker's Marks - Identifying furniture can be tricky. Crediting a maker is often a matter of "style" or "attributed to." Some makers' names come to mean entire styles or time periods, like Chippendale for example. Some styles remain popular for centuries or get revived multiple times. Well-made copies of early pieces can even fool museums. So, when you find a piece of antique furniture with a maker's mark or signature, like this Louis XVI Revival chair by Alexander Roux, which sold for \$1,230 at Brunk Auctions, it's a rare and fortunate event. The auction's description noted that Roux, a famous Victorian furniture maker who worked in New York from 1836 to 1881, had signed the chair's bronze mounts with both "Roux" and "AR." This was unusual; Roux did not often sign the mounts on his furniture. Without a maker's mark, it is sometimes possible to determine a maker based on the piece's style and provenance. Sometimes, a piece can be matched to an image in a catalog or reference book.

Q: I posed the following inquiry to Heaven Hill and they referred me to you. I have a half-gallon bottle of Daniel Stewart Kentucky Straight Bourbon Whiskey eight years old on a gold-colored wire swinging stand, probably from the 1960s or 70s. I would say that it is in mint condition. The internet says that Daniel Stewart was produced at Heaven Hill. Does anyone there know anything about this bottle? What is its value? Is it drinkable?

A: Daniel Stewart bourbon was produced by Heaven Hill for export only. Sealed bottles usually sell for about \$200 to \$300. If your bourbon was stored upright in a cool, dark place, and the cork isn't falling apart, it is probably still drinkable. Bourbon can go bad if it is exposed to light, heat or oxygen. Sometimes the alcohol can eat away at the cork, which will leave a sour and bitter taste. If you decide to drink your bourbon, smell it first; if it smells moldy, don't drink it, of course!

TIP: Put a small rug or drop cloth under a piece of furniture to move it. Pull the rug to slide the furniture across the room. This protects the furniture and floor. Don't try this over high pile carpet.

VETERANS ★ POST ★

WHEN CLAIMS AREN'T CHECKED OUT

A veteran and wife duo have been indicted for a whole menu of crimes against the VA, including conspiracy to defraud the United States, theft of government funds and conspiracy to commit wire fraud.

Their scams brought in a lot of VA benefit cash because the husband claimed a variety of problems, including traumatic brain injury, post-traumatic stress disorder and back issues, for which he was granted a 100% disability rating. By later getting a permanent and total disability rating, he no longer had to show up for any reevaluation of his condition.

The couple grabbed additional benefit cash because the wife said she was his caregiver -- since the husband claimed he couldn't even go outside and needed his wife for everything, including feeding and bathing.

Over the years the wife alone had taken in over a quarter of a million dollars. The scam fell apart when an investigation revealed that he'd never been in a combat zone and surveillance showed him driving a vehicle, doing home maintenance up on a ladder, shoveling snow and more.

How, we want to know, was this veteran thief ever approved for a permanent disability rating before anybody even looked in his personnel file and talked to former unit members? At this point the pair could get 20 years each and a fine of \$250,000. I hope this isn't like so many of the crimes against the VA where the thieves are only sentenced to a fraction of what their total sentence could be.

Because here's another case where a scammer could have been sentenced to up to five years and a \$250,000 fine, yet he ended up with a year of supervised release. In this one, the founder of a medical device company offered doctors a way to make a bit of money in the form of product development consulting fees -- for which they never actually did any work. By law those transactions should have been reported.
